

# Greenville Gun Club and COVID-19 Response

**Effective Feb 9, 2021**

*Consider these rules to supersede the Range Safety Rules.*

As Greenville County and surrounding counties continue to return to pre-holiday infection rates and as hospital utilization rates return to normal, the Board of Directors has reverted to pre-holiday rules related to our response to COVID-19.

1. **All Organized tournaments / matches are permitted subject to the decision of the managing Director.**  
Members are reminded to refer to the club calendar on our website for tournament information.
2. **Guest Maximums.** If from the same household, normal guest policy found in the range rules applies. If not from the same household, 2 guest maximum. Guests must sign-in on waiver and name must be easily legible.
3. **Gate Swipe.** Consistent with our current Range Safety Rules, all Members must swipe their access control card at the access control reader at the front, and, as necessary, lower gate. **NO PIGGYBACKING.**
4. **Skeet Tournaments.** Until Skeet has a Director that has been approved by the Board; Skeet is not permitted to hold NSSA Skeet tournaments.

**If you are sick, don't come to the Club (COVID or not). If you or a member of your immediate household is sick with COVID-19, don't come to the Club. If you cannot or will not maintain 6' social distancing, do not come to the Club.**
